NEEDLE BOOK

The project designer has two videos at the link above. The first one is about 9 minutes long and goes through ALL the steps very well. It is called "Detailed Instructions". The second one is a "Quick Overview" which is about 3 minutes long. If you have time, take a look at one of them.

From the designer: *"I love the little pockets. You can store thread, needle threaders, needle grips, and even tiny travel scissors. This book measures approximately 3.5 x 2.625 inches when finished."*

Cut out your pieces:

- From cotton fabric for needlebook cover TWO 6" x 4" rectangles
- From contrasting cotton fabric for inside pocket ONE 6" x 5" rectangle
- From lightweight fusible Interfacing TWO 6" x 4" rectangles
- From matching felt for needlebook pages TWO 5" x 3" rectangles
- From (optional) felt or thin batting for extra sturdiness in the cover ONE 6" x 4" rectangle that you will be trimming to fit
- From matching thin ribbon 12-14" length

Deep Thoughts:

To fasten your book together, you could also use the loop and a button method.

I have several needle keepers, but I want one that specifically holds the needles I use for English Paper Piecing. So I am planning on making mine out of hexagon fabric to remind me what needles inside are for!

This project would be a nice gift idea for another crafty person!
